Doctor of Psychology and psychotherapist, he specialized in Applied Behavior Analysis and Cognitive-Behavioral Psychotherapy. He is Director of Training in Behavioral and Cognitive Psychotherapy to Walden Institute of Rome and Bari. In 1981 he was among the founders and currently President, of the Italian Association of Psychology and Cognitive Behavioral Therapy. He founded in 2000 and directed until 2009, the Center for Research and Documentation on Disability of the Marche Region. His main interests relate to professional and scientific areas of application in the field of disability, special educational needs and problems of development. In 2011 he founded the Walden Technology, a company dedicated to research, testing and applications in Assistive Technology. From 2000 to 2011 was Editor in Chief of the Journal Severe Handicaps, in 2012 Journal Severe Disabilities - Cognitive Behavioral Interventions and Assistive, Technology, Editions Centro Studi Erickson. He is a member of Editorial Board of several journals and he was a member from 1997 to 2000 and from 2006 to 2009 of the Scientific Committee of the National Disability of the Ministry of Education. In 1999/2000 was National Working Partner to the European Agency for Development in Special Needs Education representing our country. Since 2004 is member on CRUI of the Conference of Rectors of Italian Universities in the bilateral scientific technical committee FIABA (Italian Fund Elimination of Architectural Barriers) CRU-TALE disability. In 2004 he was Member of the Coordinating Committee representing the Conference of Presidents of Regions and Autonomous Provinces within the Group to coordinate planning activities, monitoring during construction and all inquiries about the project and policies of the ICF job. Ministry of Labour and Social Policy. he has been being consultant of the Lega del Filo d'Oro di Osimo since 1982 and he has been being member of the Scientific Committee since 1997. He was a consulting assignments in many centers, both public and private stakeholders involved in the field of disability, special education and educational issues and development. He teaches at the Università Pontificia Salesiana di Roma and University "La Sapienza" of Rome since their foundation he has taught in the School of Specialization for Secondary School Teachers (SSIS) of the University of Lazio in 2009 and he was a member of the Committee Coordination Support Course SSIS Lazio. He teaches in the masters and doctorate at the University of the international "Foro Italico" of Rome. From 2005 to 2009 he taught at the University of Bari. He published 15 books, 21 book chapters, 5 prefaces, 96 articles in national and international, 3 software and he has been invited speaker at over 140 conferences at national and international. He was a founding member of the Italian Society of Psychology of Health and Member of Executive Committee from 2004 to 2008 as General Secretary and as Treasurer from 2010 to today.
